2. Chairpersons Annual Report on MSCG's 2015 Activities What Have We Achieved in the past 12 months?

- a. Advocating for Change
 - i. Fairfield Gully restoration group was hosted on a tour of Sandford Park
- b. Undertaking Riparian Restoration Activities
 - i. Sandford Park Planted 600 plants and weeding around existing plantings
 - ii. Resthills Park Weeding and mulching 500m completed by contractor
 - iii. Pengxin Farms (Collins Road) 1000 plants planted by contractor, blanking gaps
 - iv. Golden Farms 3300 plants planted by contractor
 - v. Collins Rd Marae weeding to remove wattle/privet seedlings
 - vi. Edgeview Crescent Gully helped out with planting days

c. Other Activities/Events

- i. Resthills Park plantings very weedy supposed to be maintained by City Council under agreement **Grant to follow up with HCC**
- ii. Collins Rd marae planting looking great some minor weeding for cherry and privet
- iii. Golden Farms 6000 plants and over 500 m of stream planted. Planned planting of another 400 m in 2017.
- iv. Peacockes Riparian Restoration Plan Landowner pulled out of proposed Peacockes planting agreement (\$60,000) which has set overall project back a year investigating other possibilities currently

d. Health & Safety

- Wasps are an issue for weeding sessions in mid-late summer with a few volunteers being stung – extra vigilance required, fly spray now available onsite at each weeding event.
- ii. HCC notifications being completed reporting info required.

What is the Value of MSCG Activities?

- Records are being kept of plant numbers, people attending working bees, hrs and other costs to enable quantification and valuing of our efforts
- ii. 2016 Planting 54hrs voluntary labour expended (\$2775) and 6600 plants planted (\$3300) with a nominal total value of \$39600.

Overall Summary

Although the number of new plants established was significantly less than the previous 2 years, overall it has been a successful year and the good growth of previous plantings is encouraging.

Discussion:

- Wetland in Sandford Park – Mike and Jackson developed plan to drain and replant with valve installation to prevent eel invasion. Currently no sign of mudfish spawning – only one large mudfish one eel found recently. Need to develop a budget for replanting. (Mike/Jackson to action)

- Sandford Park – need to plant secondary species to ensure long term succession, and infill planting in places. Need to contact Gerard at City Council to arrange (**Grant to action**).
